Recruitment to the posts of SCT Sub Inspector of Police(Civil) (Men & Women)- 355 Posts, Reserve Sub Inspector of Police (AR) (Men & Women)- 113 Posts, Reserve Sub Inspector of Police (SAR CPL) (Men)- 09 Posts, Reserve Sub Inspector of Police (APSP) (Men)- 209 Posts in Police Department and Deputy Jailor (Men)- 16 Posts & Assistant Matron (Women)- 05 Posts in Prisons & Correctional Services Department was notified vide Notification Rc.No.208/R&T/Rect.1/2016, dt: 17-09-2016.

2. The Preliminary Written Test was held on 27.11.2016 at various locations (i.e. 7 Locations 217 Centres) **from 10.00 AM to 01.00PM and 02.30 PM to 05.30 PM respectively.**

3. Answer Key for Question Booklet Series- A, B, C & D for Papers- I and II will be uploaded on the website (recruitment.appolice.gov.in) at 06.00 PM tomorrow i.e. 28.11.2016. Candidates may download the answer key. The results will be uploaded along with scanned copy of OMR Sheet within 10 days.

4. This is the first time that finger prints were captured at the centres Examination Centres for Written Examination. The Bio-Metric data captured will be utilised for further participation of candidates in Physical Measurement Test/Physical Efficiency Test and Final Written Test.

5. **1200** handheld devices along with finger prints scanners were used for capturing Bio-Metric data. **120** IT Core Team members from Districts and **20** Officers of Finger Print Bureau were involved in this process. This will ensure avoidance of impersonation and prevent cheating / malpractice in the Exam. Video graphing was also conducted.

6. The entire process was conducted peacefully with involvement of CsP/DIsG/SP's, local Police and College Staff where Exam was held.
